3/4 timing. Intro: [F] [Bb/] [C] [F] [Bb/] Start singing on G

[C7] A [F] mouse [F/C/] lived in a [Bb] windmill in [Eb] Old Amster-[Ab]-dam
A [Db] windmill with-a [F#] mouse in and [C7] he wasn't [F] growsin'
[C7] He [F] sang [F/C/] every [Bb] morning "How [Eb] lucky I [Ab] am"
[Db] "Living in a [F#] windmill in [C7] old Amster-[Bb]-dam (*slowing*) [E] [Gm7]

[F] I saw a [Bb] mouse! - [Bb] **Where?**
[F] There on the stair - [C7] **Where on the stair?** Right [E] there!
[F] A little mouse [F+] with [Bb] clogs on – [F] well I declare
Going [G7] clip-clipperty-[C7]-clop on the [F] stair, [Bb/] [C7] Oh [F] yeah [F/]

[C7] The [F] mouse [F/C/] he got [Bb] lonesome, he [Eb] took him a [Ab] wife
A [Db] windmill with [F#] mice in its [C7] hardly sur-[F]-prising
[C7] She [F] sang [F/C/] every [Bb] morning "How [Eb] lucky I [Ab] am"
[Db] "Living in a [F#] windmill in [C7] old Amster-[Bb]-dam (*slowing*) [E] [Gm7]

[F] I saw a [Bb] mouse! - [Bb] **Where?**
[F] There on the stair - [C7] **Where on the stair?** Right [E] there!
[F] A little mouse [F+] with [Bb] clogs on – [F] well I declare
Going [G7] clip-clipperty-[C7]-clop on the [F] stair, [Bb/] [C7] Oh [F] yeah [F/]

[C7] So [F] First [F/C/] they had [Bb] triplets and [Eb] then they had [Ab] quins
A [Db] windmill with [F#] quins in 'n' [C7] triplets 'n' [F] twins in
[C7] They [F] sang [F/C/] every [Bb/] morning "How [Eb] lucky we [Ab] are"
[Db] Living in a [F#] windmill in [C7] Amsterdam – [Bb] **Ya!** (*slowing*) [E] [Gm7]

[F] I saw a [Bb] mouse! - [Bb] **Where?**
[F] There on the stair - [C7] **Where on the stair?** Right [E] there!
[F] A little mouse [F+] with [Bb] clogs on – [F] well I declare
Going [G7] clip-clipperty-[C7]-clop on the [F] stair, [Bb/] [C7] Oh [F] yeah [F/]

[C7] The [F] daugh-[F/C/]-ters got [Bb] married and [Eb] so did the [Ab] sons
The [Db] windmill had [F#] christ'nins when [C7] no one was [F] listnin'
[C7] They [F] all [F/C/] sang in [Bb] chorus "How [Eb] lucky we [Ab] am"
[Db] "Living in a [F#] windmill in [C7] old Amster-[Bb]-dam (*slowing*) [E] [Gm7]

[F] I saw a [Bb] mouse! - [Bb] **Where?**
[F] There on the stair - [C7] **Where on the stair?** Right [E] there!
[F] A little mouse [F+] with [Bb] clogs on – [F] well I declare
Going [G7] clip-clipperty-[C7]-clop on the [F] stair, [Bb/] [C7] Oh [F] yeah [F/]
