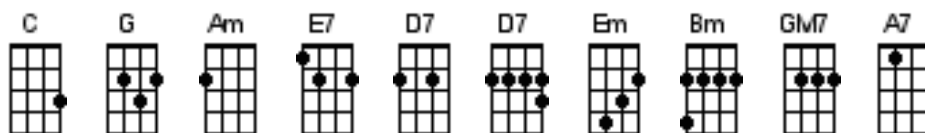


# Hark the Herald Angels Sing. Wesley. Mendelssohn
