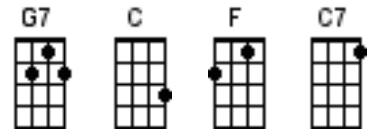


Catch a Falling Star. 1957 Perry Como. By Paul Vance and Lee Pockriss.
